Changes to Your Leaf, Brush and Bulk Items Collections Start in November!

Loose Leaf Collection

- The loose leaf collection season will be one month shorter, starting in November and ending Jan. 31.
- After leaf season, leaves must be placed in biodegradable paper bags for collection. A maximum of 10 bags per property will be removed on collection day.

Brush Collection

- Brush will be collected weekly during loose leaf collection season, November through Jan. 31.
 - Beginning February 2012, brush will be collected once every two weeks until the loose leaf collection season starts.
 - Small amounts of brush must be placed in biodegradable paper bags or tied into bundles using jute, sisal or hay baling twine (no plastic or cotton twine) if the amount is less than 30 pounds. Bundling and bagging brush allows more efficient collection, saving labor and fuel costs.
- Residents with a few sticks should allow a bagful or several armfuls to accumulate before placing brush at the curb.

Bulk Items Collection

- Bulk items will be collected once a month during the second full week of each month. If the scheduled collection day falls on a town-observed holiday, bulk items will be removed the following business day.
- Bulk items should be placed at the curb no earlier than one week before collection.
- Items that are too bulky, heavy or cumbersome may require payment of a fee based on the nature and amount of the materials and the estimated time required to perform the service.

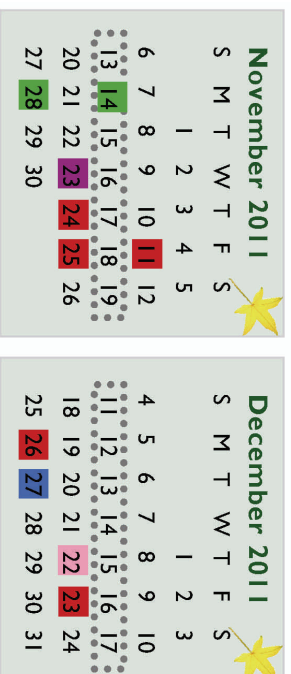

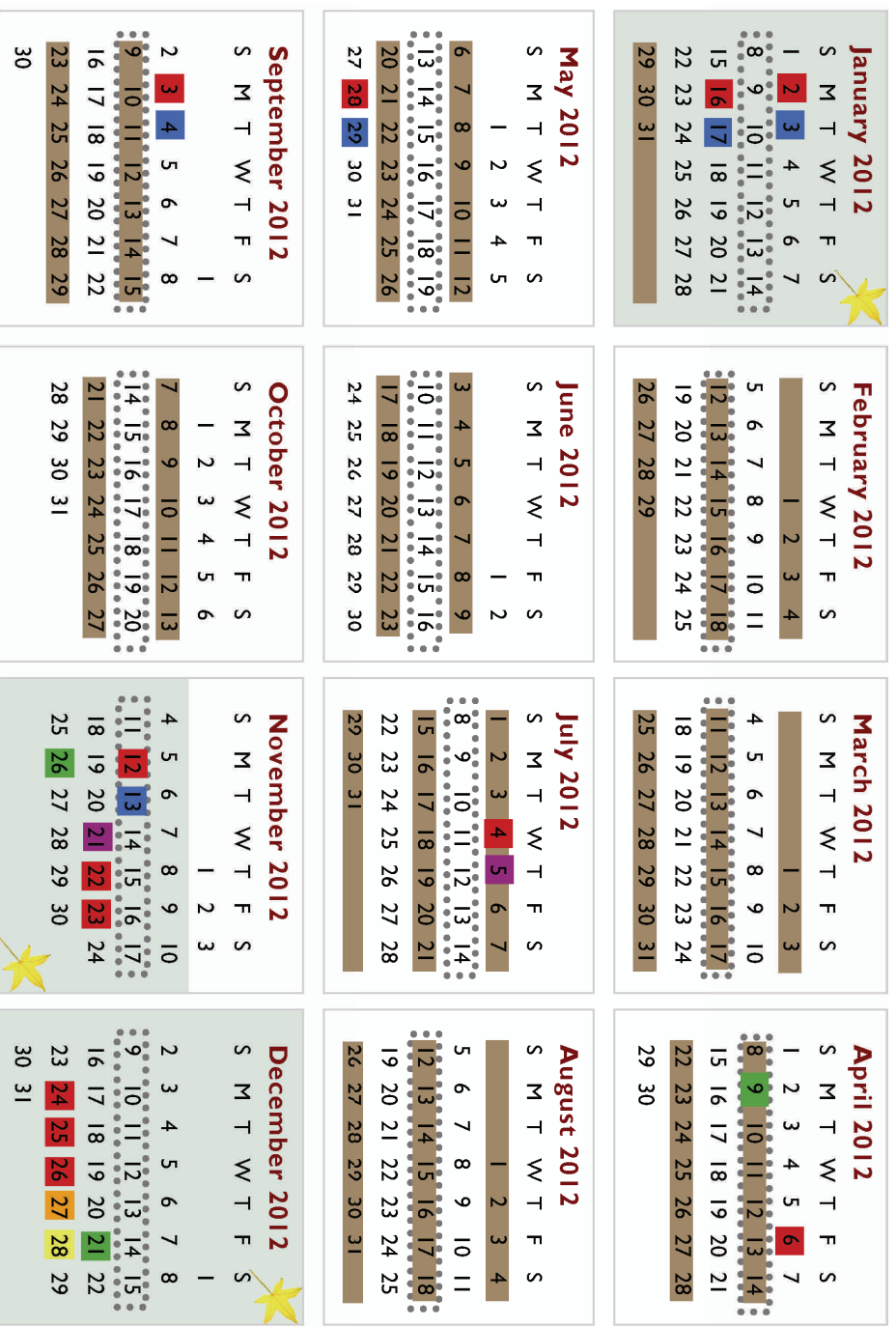
