

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 14, SECTION 22, CUSTOMER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF HILLSBOROUGH ORDAINS:

Section 1. Chapter 14, Section 22, Customer's Responsibilities is hereby revised to add the following item to the list of customer's responsibilities, as follows:

“(13) Maintain sufficient clearances around Town water and sewer apparatus located near or on customer's property to enable access, operation, and maintenance of said apparatus. No plants, objects, or structures shall be located within the required clearances. If any grading (raising or lowering of the existing ground level) is desired within this clearance, the customer shall coordinate with the Town Utilities Department to ensure that the utility devices remain accessible, and customer shall be responsible for any costs of related modifications. Clearance requirements shall include the area completely surrounding each apparatus, as measured from the center point of the device (radius), as follows:

- a) Fire Hydrants – 3 feet
- b) Manholes & concrete vaults – 6 feet
- c) Water Meters, Valve Boxes, Sewer Cleanouts, & other utilities apparatus not listed – 2 feet”

Section 2. All provisions of any Town ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
