

Town of Hillsborough Permit and Plan Review Fee Schedule

There shall be two types of permits:

1. (Operational permits) Allows the applicant to conduct an operation or a business for which a permit is required by section 105.6 of the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code for either
 - (a) A prescribed period of time.
 - (b) Until renewed or revoked.
1. (Construction permits) Allows the applicant to install or modify systems and equipment for which a permit is required by section 105.7 of the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code.
